

International Jazz Festival: December 14 to 21, 2014

Travel to Cuba with the Global Arts Media is under special license from OFAC, the U.S. Treasury Department, 31 C.F.R. §515.565(b)(2). It is a requirement of the license that each traveler have a full-time schedule of educational exchange activities that will result in meaningful interaction between the travelers and individuals in Cuba. See www.treasury.gov/resource-center/sanctions.

Following are the estimated costs for the program, based on 12 to 14 participants:

Included in the estimated costs are:

- RT Air from Miami to Havana
- Accommodations for 7 nights at the Hotel Nacional (jazz festival main venue)
- Breakfast daily at the hotel, plus welcome dinner, farewell lunch, 2 additional lunches, 1 additional dinner
- Program of visits, excursions and encounters emphasizing direct contact and dialogue with the Cuban people
- Credentials for entry to all jazz festival activities, performances and workshops
- English speaking guide
- Transportation by air conditioned bus for transfers in/out and daily for 6 hours
- Medical insurance while in Cuba
- Entry visa for Cuba
- Program and service fees

Not included: Havana airport tax of 25CUC payable at time of departure; tips and gratuities; meals or beverages not listed in the program as included or listed as "direct payment"; personal expenses.

Paperwork required to enroll

- Travel application & visa form
- Travel affidavit, completed and signed, as described above
- Flight reservation form, completed and signed
- Copy of U.S. passport valid 4-6 months beyond the date of the trip's return. If renewing, do not supply old passport but inform us of the renewal.
- Non-U.S. citizens, valid passport of that country plus U.S. residency permit or visa with re-entry permitted, If Cuban born, advise us and we will assist with any additional paperwork required

Deposit

A nonrefundable deposit of \$300 is required to reserve space on the trip. Deposit may be by check, money order or by credit card. An authorization form for payment by credit card is included in the trip application. Checks should be made out to Common Ground Education & Travel. Late applications will be considered as space is available.

Final payment and forms of payment

Final payment is due 45 days prior to departure. Individual invoices will be forwarded to each participant and will include an authorization form for credit card payment.
